Updates

- 3.) Station 19 Completed Items; Survey Updated, and Environmental Phase 1. Working items; Zoning Application, Design Layout (windows, size reduction measures), Preparation for Commission Approval.
- 4.) COVID-19 As Phase 1 reopening is fully implemented, we are beginning to prepare for Phase 2. Internally we still have Linda and Tammy alternating office days and access to the administration side of the building is restricted. In addition, access to the fire stations is still restricted and screening continues. Temperatures are taken each day before entry. Testing The state of Florida is continuing to track all fire department personnel for COVID-19 call outs, quarantined personnel, and positive test results. To date, we have had a total of 11 quarantined personnel, with 10 testing negative and returning to work. One test is still pending as of 5/26/20.

COVID-19 Testing in nursing homes and ALFs will be conducted by the state of Florida in the near future. They are looking to get a baseline of the residents. We have had DC Robertson and DC Smay going around to all of our nursing homes and ALFs to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. I am sure their efforts either have or will result in lives saved within these facilities. They have conducted many "fit tests" and made sure that they are properly stocked with PPE. Great job to both of them. County wide more than 230 of all nursing homes and ALFs have been visited by FDs. This means over 1300 contacts have been made as most facilities require many follow-up visits and contacts to make sure their personnel are ready to work safely.

- 5.) DC Smay is now working days in the new EMS Administrative position. He was moved to days effective 05/25/2020.
- 6.) New fire engine is on the road and crews have reported they like the new truck and it is running well.
- 7.) Union Contract The Union President has reported that they will be conducting a vote first week of June.
- 8.) EMS Budgets The Lealman and Tierra Verde EMS budgets have been submitted and reviewed by the county. We are at the cap on budget increases.
- 9.) Training and Event Trailers Work continues on the trailers and a special "Thank You" to the crew for painting the trailers and outfitting them for use. These efforts will help the trailers to last longer and look better during their useful life. The trailers are currently parked in the vacant field next to Station 18. A lot of hard work has gone into these new additions and the interiors are looking really nice.
- 10.) CME Training Has been on hold while COVID-19 training has been exceptionally intensive. Although the SOPs, policies, and facts about the disease change regularly, we have been spending a lot of time making sure that our personnel are updated with the latest information.
- 11.) Meetings during COVID-19 Virtually All Meetings have been on Zoom, GoTo Google Meetings, Phone conference, or other platforms during this pandemic. The Governor has extended the order allowing Public Meetings to proceed in the telephonic platform through July 7, 2020.
- 12.) Phone System The new phone system should be installed on May 27th and 28th, 2020. Our current phone system's voicemail system crashed the week of May 11, 2020 and we did our best to make it through for the new system.
